Dear Colleague,

Greetings to you!

In the recently concluded GBM; many Principals expressed varied opinions on the conduct of the TSE 2022. We wish to seek your opinion in this regard.

A brief introduction to the Talent Search examination 2022

'Talent Search Examination' is an integral part of the Karnataka ICSE Schools' Association since its inception in 2009. This examination is based on strengthening the knowledge on Current Affairs and General Knowledge amongst the student community.

A question bank with over 500 questions would be given to participants under 13 different topics which are as below:

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Details on the conduct of the exam:

## Online Mode:

1. From Mid July 2022 onwards participants log in to the TSE portal with their user name and password to the dynamic website and update themselves on a day to day basis with over 1000 questions posted based on the above mentioned topics. Students will be using a mobile/tab/desktop/laptop to log in
2. Periodic updates would be posted with regard to Current Affairs
3. Audio and Video files would be made available to participants
4. Periodic time bound Quizzes would be posted to participants and the participant gets to know his/her scores and attempt to improve the scores
5. Mock Exams would be conducted and there is scope for the participants to improve on their scores.
6. Online Final examination would be conduct **on a Sunday** in the month of November 2022. Question paper will be dynamic in nature with MCQ's audio and video-based questions as well. Timings will vary for each class.
7. Registration fee is Rupees 100/-per participant
8. Results would be declared with a fortnight
9. Each participant will get an e-participation certificate
10. Winners will get a merit certificate (hard copy) and a medal
11. Three schools with maximum number of entries will be given trophies.
12. Scores of the individual student and that of the school including school wise analysis will be generated as well.



**Offline Mode:**

1. From Mid July 2022 onwards participants will get a booklet with over 25 plus pages and roughly 50 MCQ type questions from each of the topics as mentioned above. Correct answers would be printed at the last few pages of the booklet. Participants can refer to the correct answer while revising the booklet.
2. Students revise regularly from the questions printed in the booklet until October 2022. Participating schools can revise the booklet during school hours as well
3. Final examination would be conduct in the month of November 2022 on any **working day in school**. Question papers and OMR sheets would be sent to schools well in advance and participants will read the MCQ bases question from the question paper and mark the correct option in the OMR Sheet.
4. The filled in OMR Sheets will be couriered by the respective school to KISA Office and will bear the expenses of the courier.
5. Registration fee for the offline mode would be slightly more than Rs. 100/- (as the cost of printing, stationary and others have increased)
6. Results would be declared within two months of the conduct of the TSE
7. Each participant will get a participation certificate (hard copy)
8. Winners will get a merit certificate (hard copy) and a medal
9. Three schools with maximum number of entries will be given trophies.

A Google form titled 'Talent Search Examination 2022' is posted along with this correspondence. Please ensure that you fill the form and submit it by 12 Noon of 30.06.2022 to enable the EC of KISA conclude the mode of conducting TSE 2022 which would be based on the majority of the option chosen by the member schools. Hence we request your immediate response in this regard.
